VISITATION RULES / PHONE CALLS

1. **Initial Visit:** Parents or legal guardians (only) may have one ten-minute initial non-contact visit within the first 24 hours of detainment. This ten-minute visit will be scheduled not to interfere with the daily activities. No visits shall be allowed during bedtime hours. An initial visit maybe denied if there is a reason to believe the Child's safety or the security of the facility could be in jeopardy.
2. Visits are limited to 20 minutes for each child.
3. Only members of the immediate family are allowed to visit. This includes parents, legal guardian, or spouse (with marriage license). Only two adults will be allowed to visit a child at one time.

*** **All approved family members will be allowed to visit.**
5. Approved visitors may visit with a child in the Detention Program on Saturday's only; and in the High Pride Program on Tuesday and Sunday.
6. Personal belongings will **not** be allowed in the visitation area (purses, etc.).
7. No eating, drinking, or smoking is allowed during visits. We furnish everything your child will need during his/her stay. Therefore, we ask you **NOT** to bring treats or snacks.
8. All visitors must abide by the rules and policies of the Detention Center. No loud or disorderly behavior will be tolerated. Detention staff may terminate the visit anytime he/she feels it is necessary.
9. Intoxicated individuals are not allowed to visit.
10. No children shall be permitted to have visitors unless the child is clean and neatly dressed.
11. Any attempt by the child or his/her visitors to smuggle contraband into the Detention Center shall result in the loss of visitation privileges.
12. Special visits must be approved by the Detention Supervisor.
13. All Residents that have maintained level 4 status for 5 days shall attain an extra phone call on Tuesday between 6:00 p.m.- 8:00 p.m. and an extra visitation on Sunday 1:00 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.
